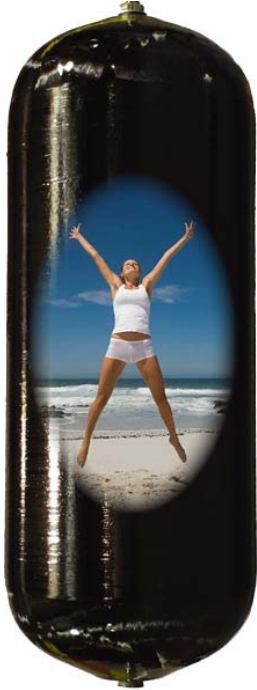


## CNG Cylinders International is initiating production of the world's largest diameter Type 3 CNG cylinder

**CNG Cylinders International (CNGci)** located in California is a supplier of Type 1 and Type 3 CNG cylinders for the North American NGV market.



CNG cylinders international is the exclusive distributor of Inflex brand Type 1 (steel) CNG cylinders for vehicular and mobile storage applications in the US.

Inflex -Argentoil S.A. of Argentina, the manufacturer, has a extensive history in manufacturing high quality CNG as well as other cylinders.

All cylinders are NGV 2-2007 and FMVSS-304, **DOT** certified and thus meet all of the US market requirements.

The Type 3 (forged aluminum liner, carbon fiber wound) cylinder is manufactured in California and is typically mounted on pickups and on heavy duty trucks.

"CNGci differentiates itself from other companies by being the only manufacturer to develop a forged liner technology through design, and by investing heavily in research and development to offer the highest quality cylinders", states Randolph Wollgiehn, Marketing Manager of CNGci. The forged 22.5"x 61" seamless Al 6061 liner holds twice the volume of a typical 16"x 60" cylinder.

Volumes currently available are 300 liter (25.5 GGE & 22.6 DGE) to 400 liter (34.2 GGE & 30.0 DGE). "An increasing amount of customers are demanding additional fuel storage capacity to maximize range which lead us to the development of a 500 liter cylinder", states Siegfried Rivalta, CNGci's president.

"We are very pleased to see the enthusiastic customer response to our large volume Type 3 cylinders and we are getting ready to take CNGci to the next level by expanding our production capacity in 2012" according to Helmut Korte, Chairman of CNGci.
